Please take a moment to read the following policy to learn how we manage your personal information.

Why we collect personal information

Learn To Draw collects and uses your personal information to give you superior customer service, to provide you with convenient access to our services, and to make a wider range available to you. In addition, we use your personal information to keep you up to date on the latest information we think you'd like to hear about. This may occasionally include information from other technology companies about products and services that can add value to your Learn To Draw service. From time to time, we may also use your personal information to contact you to participate in a market research survey, so that we can gauge customer satisfaction and develop better services.

How we collect personal information

We collect information about you in several ways. For example, we might ask for your contact information when you correspond with us, call us to request support or register for our services. We collect and store the information you provide in a secure database.

When we disclose personal information

Because Learn To Draw is a global company, your personal information may be shared with other Learn To Draw business units around the world. They will protect your personal information in accordance with the Learn To Draw Customer Privacy Policy. Learn To Draw may occasionally share your personal contact information with carefully selected companies, in regards to our unique business linking referral system. We would add further that this service may not be suitable for all business types and we respect those differences and your decline of our services in this event.

Learn To Draw works with other companies that help us provide services to you, and we may provide your personal information to these companies. At times we may be required by law or legal process to disclose your personal information. We may also disclose information about you if we believe that disclosure is necessary for the public interest.

How we protect your personal information

Learn To Draw safeguards the security of the data you send us with physical, electronic, and managerial procedures. We urge you to take every precaution to protect your personal data when you are on the Internet. Change your passwords often, use a combination of letters and numbers, and make sure you use a secure browser.

Access to your personal information

You always have access to the information we have about you. To review and update your personal contact us by [clicking here](#) and we will gladly provide this for your review and changes where necessary.

Collecting other personal information

When you browse Learn To Draw s website, you are able to do so anonymously. Generally, we don t collect personal information when you browse not even your email address. Your browser, however, does automatically tell us the type of computer and operating system you are using.

Like many website's, the Learn To Draw website uses cookie technology. When you first log in to our site, the cookie identifies your browser with a unique, random number. The cookies we use do not reveal any personal information about you, except perhaps your first name so we can welcome you on your next visit. Cookies help us understand which parts of our websites are the most popular, where our visitors are going, and how long they spend there. We use cookies to study traffic patterns on our site so we can make the site even better.

In some of our email to you, we use a click-through URL. When you click one of these URLs, you pass through our web server before arriving at the website that is your destination. We track click-throughs to help us determine your interest in particular topics and measure the effectiveness of our customer communications.

Our company wide commitment to privacy

To ensure your personal information remains confidential, we communicate these privacy guidelines to every Learn To Draw employee.

Learn To Draw does not knowingly solicit personal information from children or send them requests for personal information.

Learn To Draw's website contains links to other sites. Learn To Draw does not share your personal information with those websites and is not responsible for

their privacy practices. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policies of those companies.

If we are going to use your personal information differently from that stated at the time of collection, we will try to contact you via email using the most recent information we have. If you have not given us permission to communicate with you, you will not be contacted, nor will we use your personal information in a new manner.
